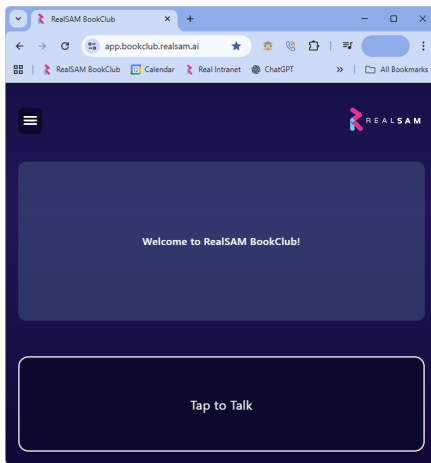


Quick Start Guide

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Getting Started

- Goto bookclub.realsam.ai
- Get a RealSAM BookClub subscription
- Get your unique activation code on email
- Use the Chrome browser if you want to use the web app.

Using BookClub

- Tap the “Tap to Talk” button in the bottom quarter of the screen.
- When the button changes to pink and the text says “listening”, you will be able to start talking with your request.
- It will change back to blue once it's thinking or ready to hear from you again. Note you can interrupt it.

 - You can interrupt BookClub at any time by saying “**Cancel**”
 - The BookClub Apps work differently from BookClub on Alexa which has much more restricted dialogue.
 - You can use BookClub across the Web, Alexa, Android and IOS and it will bookmark when you are up to.

Finding and Playing Content

Finding Books

- **What books do you have?"** (this lists options to select your recent books, your bookshelf or specific library sources such as librivox, RNIB library etc)
- **Find books by John Steinbeck**
- **Find book called *Conclave***
- **Find book titled *The Penguin Lessons***
- **List books with title *The Island***
- **Find book called *The Island by Victoria Hislop***
- **List books with title *Harry Potter***
- **List books by author Agatha Christie**
- **Find books about Christmas**
- **List books about apples**
- **Go to my recent books**
- **Go to my bookshelf**

To select a book

- Choose the option from the list you want by saying either the title or the number in the list.
- You can interrupt the dialogue at any time.

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Once you have selected a book from the list of options:

- Follow the prompts to either **“play”** the book or **“add to my bookshelf”**, to read later or **“go back”**, to return to the previous list (NB If you say **“go back”** during playback, you will jump backwards in the book)

During playback:

- To navigate a book during playback, first say **“pause”**, then say **“Jump forwards/backwards 5 minutes”** or perhaps **“Jump forwards/backwards 1 chapter”** or **“Jump forward/backward 1 section”** depending on the structure of the book.

Podcasts, Radio & Newspapers

Say things like:

- **“Find podcasts about black holes”**
- **“Play The Archers”**
- **“Play BBC Radio 4”**
- **“Listen to radio about rock music”**
- **“Listen to BBC Podcasts”**

Tips

- Some spelling or grammar might look unusual on the screen - as a primarily audio solution, we need to do this to make the web browser pronounce words more clearly
